As of July 21, 2016, the following PPS's have been released, having been revised as noted below:

PPS 13.28, Issue 19 - Storage Life of Adhesives, Sealants, Paints and Composite Products

- Specified storage life information for DYKEM Cross-Check as specified in PPS's 6.XX, 9.22, 14.XX and 19.01.
- For EC1252, specified PPS 6.XX and 14.XX to cover all referencing PPS's in the two series of PPS's. Added PPS 9.22 to the applicable PPS list as well. Deleted the applicable colours as storage life is the same for all colours.
- For F-900, specified PPS 6.XX and 14.XX to cover all referencing PPS's in the two series of PPS's. Added PPS 9.22 to the applicable PPS list as well.
- For F-925, added PPS 19.01 to the applicable PPS's.

PPS 21.19, Issue 15 - Sealing Removable Parts

- Deleted use of DSC 234-13-5 and Parting Agent 13. Specified where such release agent is specified, use MS-143H release agent/dry lubricant.
- Specified to use either MR 225 or MS-143H if no release agent is specified.
- Specified to use either MR 225 or MS-143H when the engineering drawing specifies REN RP803, Partall #10 or 2LR09 release agent.
- Specified to apply 2 thin coats for all release agents to the faying surface of the removable part or windshield frame in place of only DSC 234-13-5.

PPS 31.14, Issue 7 - Cleaning Aluminum Screen for Lay-Up in Composite Parts

- Revised Facilities Requirements section to include reference to PPS 13.39 for additional requirements.
- Reworded Facilities Requirements section as indicated by the change bar.
- Revised Personnel Requirements section to include reference to PPS 13.39 for additional requirements.
- Specified for suppliers, dispose of all chemical waste solutions according to their own national legislation and local regulations.
