PPS Revision Notice

As of January 17, 2017, the following PPS's have been released, having been revised as noted below:

PPS 10.04, Issue 18 - Heat Treatment of Aluminum and Aluminum Alloys

- Reworded Facilities Requirements section.
- Reworded Personnel Requirements section.
- Replaced the designation MIL-C-9084 with SAE AMS-C-9084 and replaced all Class 2 with Class 1 fabric.

PPS 13.26, Issue 14 - General Subcontractor Provisions

- Deleted referencing to cancelled QDI-15-02.
- Specified BAPS 160-032 as an acceptable alternative to PPS 32.05.
- Specified to see the equivalent PPS for any limitations or restrictions to using the BAPS as an alternative.

PPS 30.02, Issue 7 - Sub-Zero Treatment of Steel Parts

- Specified that this PPS is categorized as a Controlled Critical Process.
- Specified that all testing and evaluation specified in PPS 30.02 shall only be performed by Bombardier Toronto Materials Laboratory or by laboratories accredited according to BAERD GEN-018.
- As this process is no longer being performed in Bombardier Toronto, hence, specified that safety precautions applicable to the materials and procedures specified herein shall be defined by the subcontractor performing the work for Bombardier Toronto.
- Revised Personnel Requirements section wording.
