

As of March 10, 2017, the following PPS's have been released, having been revised as noted below:

PPS 6.14, Issue 16 – Swage Installation of Wiggins and Hydraflow Fittings

- Expanded scope of this PPS to include swaging and installation of Wiggins and Hydraflow fittings with threaded closures.
- Removed “PS#” references from [Table 1](#) (Tool Part Numbers); PS#'s are for Bombardier Toronto (de Havilland) internal use only.
- Added procedure and requirements for swaging and installation of the B0305118 threaded body as part of a fitting with threaded closure.

PPS 9.24, Issue 11 – Wire and Cable Stripping

- Replaced operating instructions specific to particular manual and automatic stripping tools and machines with an instruction to operate manual and automatic stripping tools and machines according to the equipment manufacturer's instructions.
 - Added a general safety precaution indicating that the safety precautions specified in this PPS are specific to Bombardier Toronto (de Havilland) and that suppliers, subcontractors and partners are responsible for ensuring that their own environmental, health and safety precautions satisfy the appropriate local government regulations.
