



PPS Revision Notice

As of March 16, 2021, the following PPS's have been released, having been revised as noted below:

PPS 31.17, Issue 50 - Solvent Usage

- Added option of DS108 for the cleaning of test panels before copper sulphate testing (ref. PPS 31.05).
- Added solvent option, IPA, for cleaning of uncured sealant from tools and equipment as specified in PPS 21.03, PPS 21.05 and PPS 21.18.

PPS 34.11, Issue 23 - Priming and Painting of DASH 8 Aircraft Exterior Surfaces

- Replaced throughout PPS where "Bombardier" is specified with "De Havilland Aircraft of Canada Limited" or "DHC".
- Specified use of the following Bombardier Aerospace documents at the specified frozen revisions: BAERD GEN-007, Rev. C; BAERD GEN-023, Rev. A; and BAPS 138-055, Rev. D.
- Revised Facilities Requirements section.
- Defined MRB.
- Allowed use of 120 grit size abrasive paper for intermediate surface preparation of metallic parts.
- Specified a range of $\pm 5^{\circ}\text{F}$ ($\pm 3^{\circ}\text{C}$) for temperature and $\pm 10\%$ relative humidity range for high solids F24 drying times before taping and overcoating.
- Added new Disposal of Chemical Wastes section.
- Specified to always use the oldest stock first (i.e., first in/first out (FIFO) basis).
